Let's talk about your Soul, it is often referred to as the immaterial, non-physical essence or part of the being that is believed to survive the death of the body and is considered to seat your consciousness, emotions and individuality.

- Seat of consciousness refers to your soul being seen as the source of your awareness, thoughts and feelings.

- Your soul is believed to be the unique and the defining aspect of yourself, contributing to your personality and character.
- Many spiritual traditions hold that your soul continues to exist after the death of your physical body, potentially entering a new realm or continuing its journey in some form.
- Reincarnation or rebirth is the belief that after death, your soul transmigrates into a new body or continues its journey through various lifetimes.
- Some believe that reincarnation is a process of spiritual growth and learning, where your soul experiences different lives to refine itself.
- The timeline for reincarnation could be linear or non-linear, this is a matter of belief and philosophical interpretation, here are some different perspectives:
  - o Linear time is where your soul reincarnates sequentially through different lives, moving forward in a continuous stream.
  - Non-linear time suggests that reincarnation potentially experiences multiple lives simultaneously or in different order and even revisiting past timelines.
  - Some philosophical and spiritual perspectives suggest that time is not a fixed, linear dimension, but rather a fluid or malleable concept.

- There is no scientific evidence to support or refute the concept of reincarnation and therefore no scientific basis for determining whether the timeline is linear or non-linear, instead it's intertwined with cultural and spiritual beliefs, which can vary widely.
- Some spiritual beliefs posit that your soul has a connection to a higher power or divine source and that your soul's purpose is to connect with or return to that source.
- Here are some different religious beliefs regarding your soul:
  - Within Christianity your soul is often viewed as the immaterial part of a human being that is created by God and survives death, potentially entering heaven or hell.
  - Where Hinduism your soul or Atman, is considered an eternal part of the universal soul, Brahman and is believed to undergo reincarnation until it achieves enlightenment.
  - o Then Islam your soul or Ruh is a divine creation that is breathed into humans by God and is believed to be judged after death.
  - Finally Judaism your soul or Neshamah is the essence of a person's being and is believed to be a divine spark that is connected to God.

Your subconscious mind and soul are often discussed together, particularly in spiritual or philosophical contexts, but they are distinct concepts. Your subconscious mind is a part of your mental processes while your soul is often seen as the non-physical spiritual entity. Our next sermon will be about your Subconscious Mind.
